TOURNAMENT RULES



1. REGISTRATION WILL BE AT HOOKS MARINA THE MORNING OF EACH TOURNAMENT.

- 2. All contestants will leave from the Spillway Ramp per order of Tournament Director
- 3. THERE WILL BE A TOURNAMENT MEETING with Teams and Tournament Director before each Tournament starts.
- 4. All Tournaments start at 6AM or OTHERWISE time set by Tournament Director.
- 5. Must check in 8 hours from launch at designated site for check in.
- 6. All fish MUST be 12" long and each team may weigh-in (5) live fish.
- 7. THERE WILL BE NO DEAD FISH BROUGHT TO THE SCALES.
- 8. Scoring will be by digital scales and only largemouth bass may be used.
- 9. In cases of ties, the largest bass on the stringer will decide the place.
- 10. In matters of question, the decision of the Tournament Committee will be FINAL.
- 11. Only rod and reels with artificial lures may be used. NO trolling.
- 12. Contestants may not leave the boat to obtain a fish.
- 13. No fishing within 50 yards of another tournament contestant that is tied or anchored, unless invited.
- 14. No fishing within 100 yards of weigh-in release site.
- 15. All contestants must wear approved life vests and kill switch must be attached when the big engine is running.
- 16. Participants 16 years or younger must be accompanied by a parent or an adult with written permission.
- 17. EACH CONTESTANT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR KNOWING AND UNDERSTANDING THESE RULES.
- 18. Caney Lake Bass Circuit, Hooks Marina and any of our sponsors SHALL NOT BE HELD LIABLE for personal injury or lost, damaged, or stolen property or accidents.
- 19. All fish will become property of Caney Lake Bass Circuit. The first fish you give to the Weigh Master is BIG BASS.
- 20. All anglers must fish or pay for 3 of the 4 tournaments to qualify for the Championship. \$150 PER BOAT!
- 21. A boat check prior to take off will be performed.
- 22. This Tournament is designed primarily for amateurs, therefore, anyone who has fished 5 or more tournaments within the past 12 months of this tournament with any entry free over \$1000 or anyone who has provided guide service for pay within the past 90 days of this official tournament lake,will not be eligible to compete in this tournament.
